Egyptian vulture general assessment

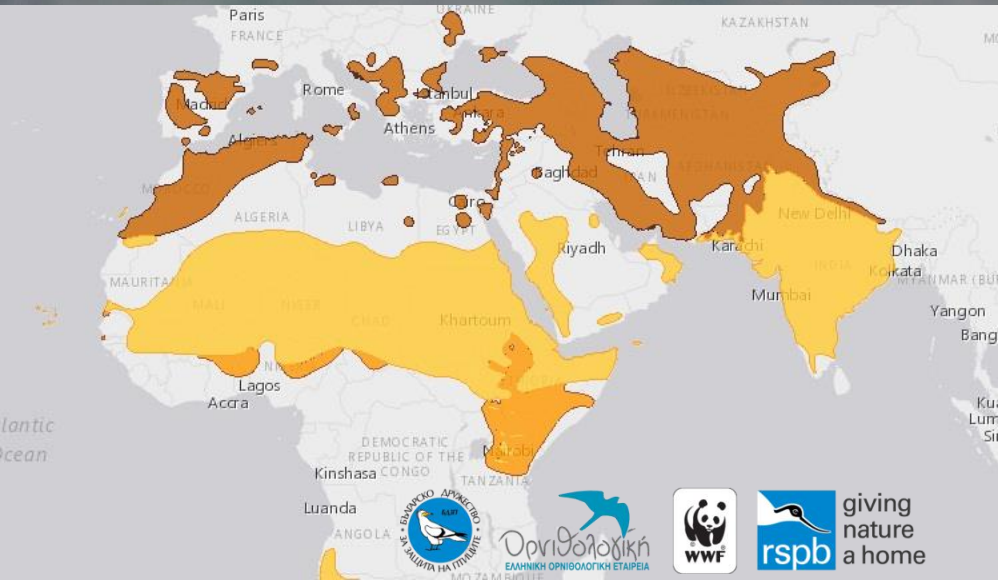
Status: Endangered

Global population estimates:

- **Europe** - 3,300-5,050 pairs
- **Central Asia** - < 2000 pairs
- **India** – few thousand pairs
- **Middle East** – 1000 pairs
- **Africa** – 1000 – 2000 pairs

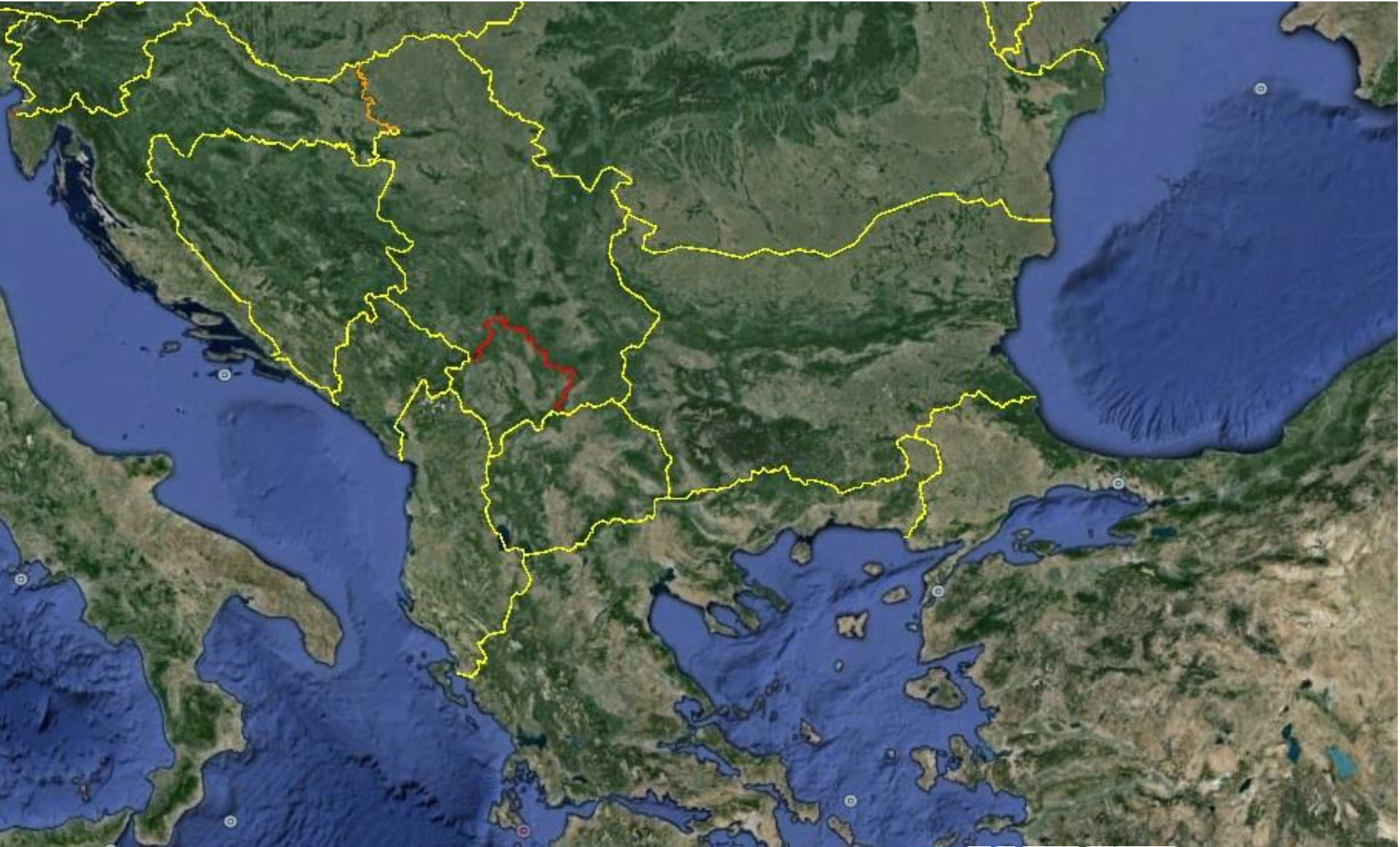
Total: 21 900 – 30000 Individuals

Population trend: *Decreasing*

Serbia – probably extinct

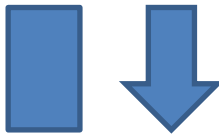
Total: about 80 pairs

Range states:

Russia (Caucasian region) – 120 – 220 pairs, unknown

Georgia – 30 – 50 pairs, decline

Azerbaijan – 200 – 500 pairs, stable

Armenia – 35 – 60 pairs, stable

Kazakhstan – 80 – 100 pairs, decline

Turkmenistan – 60 – 70 pairs, decline

Uzbekistan – 135 pairs, decline

Tadzhikistan – 25 – 30 pairs, unknown

Kyrgyzstan - several hundreds, unknown

Total: 700 - 1300 pairs

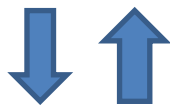
Population trend: *Stable or probably declining*

Syria – 4 pairs, decline

Cyprus – 5 pairs, decline

Israel – 35 pairs, decline

Iran – 200 - 400 pairs, unknown

Iraq – 100 - 200 pairs, unknown

Yemen – 800 pairs, stable

Oman – 65 – 80 pairs, increase

Saudi Arabia - unknown

Jordan- extinct

Lebanon – extinct

United Arab Emirates - extinct

Total: > 1500 pairs

Population trend: *Fluctuating*
